buses. If you ever thought
about becoming a driver,
here is some basic
information to get started.



- Step 1. Fill out an application with your local school district.
- Step 2. Complete the SCDE School Bus Driver Classroom Training Program, including Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT) if you will need a commercial driver's license (CDL).
- Step 3. Show through a medical examination that you are physically able to drive a bus and can see and hear well.
- Step 4. If required, make passing scores on written examinations at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to get a commercial learner's permit (CLP).
- Step 5. Pass required substance use tests before beginning any behind-the-wheel training.
- Step 6. Pass a physical dexterity test to show you can move quickly in and around a bus.
- Step 7. Complete behind the wheel instruction.
- Step 8. Pass road skills tests, which include an inspection of the bus and driving exercises to make sure you can safely operate the bus.
- Step 9. If required, exchange your CLP for a CDL at the DMV.
- Step 10. Congratulate yourself for completing all training and testing for your SCDE School Bus Driver's Certificate. You are now ready to go to work!
